If you are a charity or organisation that works with homeless people, you are warmly invited to take part in this event to raise vital funds for your work. You do not need to be a Christian organisation to take part.

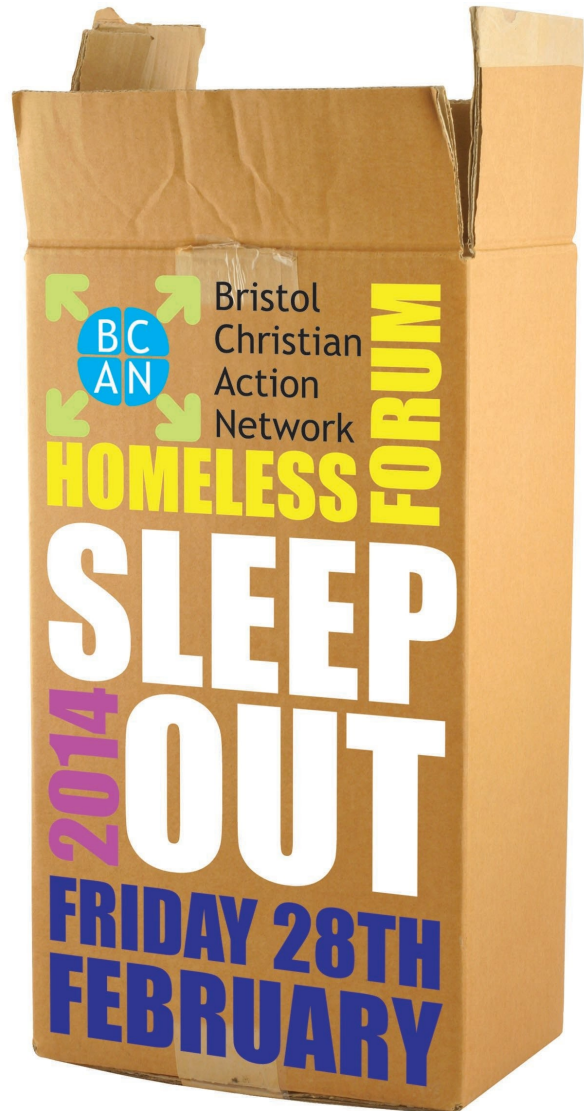
Event Background
